2023 CHRISTMAS DOUBLES/SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. <u>Participation</u>: Competition is open to all TNBA/USBC current members in good standing and will be operated under the tournament rules of the TNBA/USBC. Any member that cannot show proof or verification of his/her TNBA membership prior to bowling will be required to purchase the necessary membership on site, \$25.
- 2. <u>Doubles/Singles</u>: Doubles lineup will be assigned in the order as listed on the entry form. Only tournament officials may make changes in lineup prior to bowling start time. There will be Handicap and Scratch breakouts for each division based on entries. Doubles may consist of any combination: male /male, female/female, or male/female. You must bowl both events, DOUBLES WILL BE ROLLED FIRST. Both doubles partners must elect optional scratch in order to bowl optional scratch doubles.
- 3. Entry Fee: Entry fee will be \$30.00 per person, per event with \$12.50 for prize fee, \$14.50 for lineage and \$3.00 for expenses. Doubles and Singles Scratch Event will be \$10.00 per person with \$8.00 for prize fee and \$2.00 for expense fee.
- 4. <u>Prize Fund:</u> Prize fund will be returned 100% in each event with a ratio of at least 1 prize or major fraction thereof for each 5 entries.
- 5. <u>Handicap</u>: Will be computed on a basis of 90% of the entrant's average and 220 for both men and women. Computations will be figured on a three-game set.

6. Entering Average:

- a. All entrants must have a USBC certified league average. Use the highest 2022-2023 yearbook average. If no yearbook average, you MUST provide documentation in writing either by a copy of a standing sheet from the league or documentation signed by league secretary, using your HIGHEST current certified average of 21 games or more as of Dec 1, 2022. No Summer League 2022-2023 averages will be accepted. All others must bowl scratch. All averages must be for 21 or more games. The yearbook will be official. All averages must be able to be verified or you will bowl scratch.
- b. No Ten Pin Rule.
- c. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their average. If a bowler uses an average lower than their required average, they shall be disqualified. If a higher average is submitted, prize winnings will be based on the higher average. (Rule 319a)
- d. Entrants who have qualified for \$300 or more in cash and /or merchandise in a single event, the combined prize money won in excess of \$500 in a tournament, and/or the combined prize money won in excess of \$1000 in all tournaments completed within 12 months shall report their winnings to the tournament officials. (Rule 319d)
- 7. Scheduling: Check in will be 45 minutes prior to the assigned squad time. Team Captains must report any changes to the tournament office.
- 8. <u>Dress Code:</u> All entrants are required to wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament. No short shorts, swimsuits, tank tops or any other inappropriate attire will be allowed. Inappropriate attire will be determined tournament directors.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entrant not in compliance with the TNBA/USBC rules of the tournament. The USBC Rule Book will be used as reference for any and all rules, decisions, and complaints deemed necessary by the Tournament Directors.

Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament management in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
