#### 2024 THREE PERSON BAKER TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. **Eligibility:** Competition is open to current adult members of USBC in a certified league at any certified center. Bring proof of current season USBC membership verification.
- 2. Divisions: Hdcp and Optional Scratch divisions. Each team will bowl 6 games.
- **3. Participation:** You may enter as many times as there is time available for that day. In no case shall the same team partners be permitted to place more than once in the prize fund for the tournament.
- **4. Entry Fee:** Entry fee will be \$90.00 per three-person team, with \$58.00 for prize fee, \$29.00 for lineage and \$3.00 for expenses. An optional Scratch Division will be \$30.00 per three-person team, with \$24.00 for prize fee, \$3.00 for BVL and \$3.00 for expenses, and will use your handicap scores bowled.
- **5. Prizes:** Prize fund will be returned 100% in in this tournament with a ratio of at least 1 prize or major fraction thereof for each 5 entries, for both Handicap and Scratch division.
- **6. Awards:** Awards will be given to the winners in each event from the expense fee to be presented during the Open Association meeting/Awards program. Duplicate awards will be given for 1st Place Ties.
- 7. Average: Averages will be accepted in the following order:
  - a. Highest certified 2023-2024 Yearbook league average.
  - b. Highest 2024 summer league average.
  - c. A former Youth bowler may use their highest 2023-2024 Youth certified average.
  - d. All averages are for 21 games or more (USBC Rule 319a1).
  - e. If none of the above applies, entrants must bowl scratch.
- **8. Handicap:** Handicap will be computed on a basis of 90% of the team's cumulative average divided by 3 and 220. Computations will be figured on a three (3) game set. Example Player 1 180, Player 2 200, Player 3 175: Total cumulative average = 555, divide by 3 = 185; 220 185 = 35 times 90% = 31 pins (rounded to whole integer number) handicap per game for the team.
- 9. Ten pin rule does NOT apply
- 10. Scheduling: First come first scheduled up to the ending time.
- 11. Protests: Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament management in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
- 12. Team/person rotation for 6 games. No line-up changes between games.
