

2024 Mulligan #1 Tournament Rules

- 1. Eligibility: Competition is open to current adult & youth members of USBC in a certified league at any certified center. Bring proof of current season USBC membership verification.
- 2. Divisions: There will be two separate divisions for both the adult and youth competitors. Division A will be for bowlers entering the tournament with a 175 average or higher. Division B will be for bowlers entering the tournament with a 174 and lower average.
- **3. Participation:** You may enter the tournament as many times as there are shifts. Highest series will count for prize fund. Competitor will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes. At the end of the three game set, the competitor will have the option to bowl a Mulligan Game (4th Game) to replace their lowest score bowled at an additional cost of \$12.00. This additional game will be bowled on a pair of lanes designated by the Tournament Director as the Mulligan Pair. The additional Mulligan game will replace the chosen lowest game of the original three game set regardless of score.
- 4. Entry Fees and Prizes: All entry fees must be accompanied by the entry form or the entry will not be accepted. Prize Fund for the Adult Division will be paid out with at least one (1) prize for every five (5) entries or major portion thereof. Prize Fund for the Youth division will be paid out with at least one (1) prize for every five (5) entries or major portion thereof for scholarship money. (Deposited in SMART Account) All prize fees will be returned 100% in the division in which fees were collected. Awards will be given to the winners in each event from the expense fee to be presented during the Open Association meeting/Awards program.
- 5. Average & Handicap: Averages will be accepted in the following order:
 - a. Highest certified 2023-2024 Yearbook league average.
 - b. Highest 2024 summer league average.
 - c. A former Youth bowler may use their highest 2023-2024 Youth certified average.
 - d. All averages are for 21 games or more (USBC Rule 319a1).
 - e. If none of the above applies, entrants must bowl scratch.
 - f. Handicap is based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
- 6. Rule 319a2 Ten pin rule does apply.
 - Rule 319a3 Each bowler is responsible for verifying their average.
 - Rule 319a4 Corrections to bowler's average can be made up to the end of the first series bowled.

Rule 319d – Bowlers who have qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300.00 or

more in any event in a Tournament within the previous 12-month period, even though payment of the prize has not been made, must report Actual Score, Position, and Amount won to the Tournament at the time of bowling for possible re-rating. Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses to re-rate, entry fees will be refunded. Entrants have the right to appeal any re-rate to USBC within 10 days of the date of bowling.

- 7. Ties: If there are ties in any event, prize money will be combined and divided equally.
- 8. **Protests:** Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament management in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
- **9.** Tardy Bowlers: Any bowler arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score will count beginning in the frame being bowled. The frames missed will be scored as zero (0). (Rule 315).
- 10. Tournament management reserves the right to change these rules prior to the start of tournament play.
- 11. Any rule not addressed in these rules will be covered by the 2024-2025 USBC Rule Book.
