#### Rules:

- 1. Eligibility: Competition is limited to Middle Georgia USBC adult members and youth members bowling in youth leagues in a certified league at any center serviced by the that Association and must be in good standing.
- Format: Singles Tourn. Individuals will bowl four (4) games on one (1) pair of lanes assigned by the Tournament Director.
- 3. Averages: Averages will be accepted in the following order:
  - a. Highest certified 2024-2025 yearbook league.
  - Highest current average as of Dec 31, 2025.
  - Highest 2025 summer league average.
  - A former Youth bowler may use their highest 2024-2025 Youth certified average.
  - All averages are for 21 games or more (USBC Rule 319a1).
  - If none of the above applies, entrants must bowl scratch.
  - Bowlers are responsible for verifying their average (Rule 319a3, 4).
- 4. Handicap: Handicap will be computed on a basis of 90% of the difference between 220 and the bowlers entering average.
- 5. Ten pin rule does NOT apply (USBC Rule 319a2).
- 6. Prizes: All prize money will be returned 100%. Distribution will be at least 1 for every 5 entries or major fraction thereof for the Ladies and Men's Division. Distribution will be at least 1 for every 5 entries or major fraction thereof for the Youth Division in the form of scholarship money (deposited in SMART). Awards will be given to winners in each division from the expense fee to be given out at the Open Association Annual meeting/Awards program.
- 7. Protests: Protests must be filed within the time limits in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 8. The appointed Tournament Director reserves the right to change the tournament rules prior to the start of tournament play.
