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## 2025 Middle Georgia USBC Youth Championship Tournament Rules

- 1. All 2024-2025 certified members bowling in youth leagues in a center under the jurisdiction of Middle Georgia USBC in good standing are eligible to enter. A member in good standing will have applied for a regular season membership to a local processing agent.
- 2. The teams will consist of four members. Names will be submitted in the order the members bowl. NO LINE UP CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED. Substitutes will assume the position of the member she/he is replacing. There are no separate boys and girls division for team and doubles. A member that bowls singles must bowl doubles. SINGLES WILL BE BOWLED FIRST.
- 3. AWARDS Awards will be presented in each division with a prize ratio of 1 to 5 or major fraction thereof. In addition, awards will be presented for the highest game, series, and all events (scratch and handicap). USBC Championship Emblems will be awarded in each division in team, doubles, singles and all events handicap. All participants will receive an award. In case of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> Place Co-Champions will be declared.
- 4. FEES Entry fee is \$ 16.50 per person per event broken down as follows: \$ 8.25 for bowling fees and \$ 8.25 for trophy fees.
- 5. HANDICAP Handicap will be 90% of the difference between a bowler's average and 200.
- 6. AVERAGE Bowlers will use their highest USBC league average as of 31 Dec 2024 with 12 games or more bowled. Bowlers that do not have a 12-game average as of 31 Dec 2024 will use their current average of 12 games or more as of 3 Feb 2025. All others will bowl scratch. Divisions are determined by adding the member averages together for that event.
- 7. DRESS CODE Participants are expected to wear suitable attire during competition. All clothes must be neat, clean and free of holes or frayed hemlines. Acceptable Tops include full length shirts or bowling jerseys with polo, butterfly, or sash collars, or t-shirts with league logos. Acceptable Bottoms include pants, nice jeans, capris, walking/casual shorts no more than 2 inches above the knees, skirts and/or skorts at least fingertip length. Attire or equipment depicting alcohol, illegal substances, gambling, or inappropriate language/gestures is forbidden in accordance with USBC Rule 301b. Tournament Officials will determine appropriate attire, and those decisions are final. (USBC Rule 301b Youth and USBC Rule 303 Management).
- 8. The use of ALCOHOLIC beverages and TOBACCO products shall not be permitted. Participants shall not play game machines from check-in time until their shift is completed. FLASH pictures cannot be taken while the tournament is in progress. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of Youth Bowling will not be tolerated.
- 9. CHECK-IN Bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time. Bowlers that are tardy shall receive the score of ZERO for each frame missed.
- 10. Tournament games cannot be rebowled, except as authorized by the tournament director when scores are lost from an authorized scoring device. The tournament director will handle any disputes, complaints, or protests.
- 11. Multiple entries allowed twice in each event. (2 times in Team and 2 times in Singles/Doubles events) Teams must have two or more different bowlers and doubles must have different partners. First three games bowled in each event will count for All Events.
